- Refunds (less registration fee) will be provided if you must cancel. **Cancellations** must be **received by July 6th 2010**.

Housing

- Family housing (Roush and Baker Halls) consists of two or four dorm rooms sharing a common bathroom. Each dorm room has two beds (long twin size).
- Please indicate on the registration form those with whom you'd prefer to share a bathroom.
- Couples without children in their room or adult singles will likely be housed in Miller or Meadows, with separate common men's and women's bathrooms per floor. Pods with 4-5 rooms are great for groups!
- Families with four or fewer members will share one room.
- Common areas with laundry, microwave, a small refrigerator and vending machines are in all dorms.

Under 18

- All children (under 18) must be accompanied by a responsible adult (either parent or guardian).
- Guardians must be age 21 and over and assume full responsibility for the child/children in their care.
- The Guardian's signature must appear on the registration form.
- A **Liability Release Form** must be completed by all campers under 18 who attend Midwest Camp without a parent present.
- All campers from 13 to 18 years of age must read the **Teen Guidelines** and sign the registration form.

Teen Guidelines

- We are guests at Huntington University. Appropriate behavior is expected of all those attending Midwest Camp.
- Any camper whose behavior is deemed to be inappropriate by the camp staff will be subject to dismissal from the camp grounds.
- Repair of damages to rooms or property will be the responsibility of those causing the damage.
- Proper modest attire, including shoes (no bare feet,) is to be worn at all times (no bikinis or tummy-baring apparel).

Infants and Children

- Children entering the 7th grade and under will room with their parent(s) or guardian.
- Plan to bring the items your younger children require – crib, playpens, high chair, etc.
- Each room has two twin beds that are capable of stacking as bunk beds. Sleeping bags/air mattresses are necessary when more than 2 people are staying in a single room.

Bed Linens and Towels

- Bed linens and towels are available and may be rented at \$7.75/set. **Please order and include payment with your registration.**
- **Pillows are NOT available** (bring your own).
- Pick-up linens and towels when you register.

Recreation Facilities

- All recreational facilities at the university are available for use by campers. Facilities include a gymnasium (**you must bring a separate pair of gym shoes to use the gym**), field house, tennis courts, racquetball courts, soccer and baseball fields, shuttle to indoor swimming pool, and fishing pond.

What to Bring, Not to Bring

- Bring your Bible, notebook, pens/pencils, bathrobe, towels, soap, hangers, bed linens (extra long twin; rentals are available-see above), pillows, blankets and infant care items (high chair, crib, etc.).
- Leave your radios, boom boxes and TVs, skateboards, scooters and in-line skates at home. No cooking appliances or open flames (candles) are allowed in dorm rooms.
- The possession, sale, or use of tobacco products, alcohol, fireworks, or illegal drugs is prohibited on campus.

Part-Time Campers

- Priority housing is given to full-time campers on a first-come, first-serve basis.
